ANALYTICAL REPORT

On November 1st 2006, nine items of evidence were received from Calvin Jackson, BlueStar USA, via UPS (#1ZXF62830290946403). All nine consisted of bloodstains which have been treated with a liquid. As per Mr. Jackson samples 5, 6, 7 and 8 were subjected to ABO testing using an Absorption Elution procedure. All four items tested (items 5, 6, 7 and 8) gave ABO reactions consistent with an ABO type A individual.
